What's new?

Changes abound at AMGH! This past year has seen the planning and replacement of the elevator. With this upgrade we will be adding accessibility features, emergency call phone, and will be installing features that will work with our patient wander system. This project should be complete by March 11, 2022.

Secure Room

As part of the All in Capital Campaign undertaken by the AMGH Foundation the planning and implementation of a secure room in the ER is underway. AMGH is a designated "schedule One" mental health facility. Mental health patients are often transferred to AMGH from other hospitals that do not have Mental Health Units. The hospital has designated one exam room that will be renovated to make the space safe for patients and staff. The addition of a secure room will ensure that patients can safely be held prior to being admitted the Mental Health Unit. We are finalizing plans with the architects and anticipate a start date in April or May.

Pharmacy Cabinets

We are thrilled to announce that our new automated Pharmacy Cabinets systems has gone live. These systems will create more security around drug dispensing for our nursing staff and implement more efficiency for them. Funded by YOU the community through the





Foundation! This was a \$710,000 project that we are so happy to have online in our emergency department, our inpatient unit and our operating rooms.

AMGH prides itself on providing many services which are not always offered in similar-sized communities, including 24/7 Emergency Department, Outpatient services, Obstetrics, Telestroke, CT Scanner, Surgical Services, ICU, Dialysis and regional services in Mental health and Addictions. Having these services close to home makes a significant difference in the lives of local patients.
